Application

- The temperature of the object must be above +10° C.
- Area to be treated has to be clean and dry

Absorbent (matt) materials

- Apply Finalit No.21 to the clean and dry surface by spraying or rolling
- Drying time up to 1 hour
- A subsequent Finalit impregnation is recommended

Polished (glossy) materials

- Apply Finalit No.21 to the clean and dry surface by spraying or rolling. Spread evenly. Be Careful not to over-apply!
- Drying time up to 1 hour. Then polish with white pad and high-speed machine.
- If smears should appear as a result of over-generous application, apply Finalit No.21 once more and wipe the surplus away
- A subsequent Finalit impregnation is recommended



Properties

- Finalit No. 21 Fixative is unsaponifiable and has, based on the specific composition, an excellent adhesion to porous and chalk surfaces and is therefore used as a stabiliser and adhesion mediator for subsequent coats.
- In the case of stone it closes the pores

Effect on Plaster

- Through weathering, the plaster breaks down into particles, which lay loose on the surface. In depths of 2-3 mm the lime can become damaged through industrial pollution, and this layer becomes loose and porous.
- Finalit No. 21 Fixative easily penetrates these layers and stabilises these loose particles

Pro-Tip

- Particularly suitable for the pre-treatment of Chinese granites, basalts, and many other absorbent materials before installation to prevent water absorption, efflorescence, and stains
